ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION:

Mercy Rehabilitation Society, Sawaimadhapur was registered under Rajasthan Society Registration Act, 1958 wide number 70/Sawaimadhapur/2008-09 dated 19.08.2008. It is also registered under section 52 (2) of Persons with Disability Act,

1995 wide registration number 295 / Jaipur 2010-11 dated 27.01.2011 and under section 12 (4) of The National Trust for The Welfare Of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities Act, 1999 wide Registration number 091218331426028 / MR / CP / AUTISM / MD dated 19.12.2013 and 12 AA Registration under Income Tax Act, 1961 IC/ITO(T)/Kota/12 AA/2014-15/688 and 80 G Registration under Income Tax Act, 1961 wide Registration number IC/ITO(T)/Kota/12 AA/2014-15/689 dated 19.06.2014 with the noble cause to render all sorts of services.

Since its inception, it has taken up strong commitment for development in inclusive society for all. For empowerment of the persons with disabilities this institute has been rendering several services for the Inclusive & special education, rehabilitation and empowerment of the persons with disabilities. OBJECTIVES:

- To run special schools, Rehabilitation homes and Sub centers for the educational rehabilitation of persons with disabilities.
- To encourage intellectual, social, economic & cultural development among the people including the disabled of all ages.
- To conduct special camps in rural & urban areas for early identification and intervention measures on various issues related to community development, welfare & rehabilitation of individuals with disabilities.
- To provide vocational training and start income generating programmes for persons with disabilities and formation of self-help groups.

- To protect the rights of persons with disabilities.
- To implement Community Based Rehabilitation Programmes for PwDs. To undertake extension and outreach programmes in the sawaimadhopur.
- To run old age home for the aged, shelter home for deserted and destitute persons.

MENTAL RETARDATION

Mental Retardation is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of the mind, which is especially characterized by impairment of skills manifested during the developmental period, skills which contribute to the overall level of intelligence, that is, cognitive, language, motor and social abilities.

Characteristics of Mental Retardation

1. Absence of clarity
2. Age inappropriate behavior
3. Delay in development
4. Inability to decide
5. Inability to learn fast
6. Inability to understand quickly
7. Inability to remember
8. Lack of concentration
9. Lack of motor coordination
10. Slow reaction

Classification of Mental Retardation – as per ICD 10 (International Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems, 10th Edition Published by World Health Organization.)

Mild Mental Retardation	IQ level 50-69
Moderate Mental Retardation	IQ level 35-49
Severe Mental Retardation	IQ level 20 to 34
Profound Mental Retardation	IQ level below 20

MUSKAN SPECIAL SCHOOL CUM REHAB CENTRE FOR MULTIPLE DISABILITIES:

The Mercy Rehabilitation Society, Sawaimadhopur has a special school namely Muskan Special School cum Rehab Center for Multiple Disability under the umbrella of Deen Dayal Upadhyal Rehabilitation Scheme of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi. The Centre was initiated with a purpose to provide specialized and comprehensive rehabilitation services to the children with intellectual disability. The school is equipped with qualified professionals providing quality education and training to the children with intellectual disability.

The Centre is providing education and training to children with intellectual disability in order to develop their innate potential to the maximum. The school has strength of 47 children with disability. The service activities include psychological assessment, physiotherapy, speech therapy, parent counseling etc. The Centre also conducts regular curricular and co-curricular activities for them. The children of the centre have been participating in painting.

The special school is very much comprehensive about the special education and rehabilitation of children with intellectual disabilities. The Professional evaluated performance of child and informed their parents. They are also maintaining records of children. Apart from the curricular activities, the special school is also focusing on the development of co - curricular activities of the children with intellectual disabilities.



DETAILS OF CHILDREN WITH DISABILITY:

The children are taught by qualified special educator. They are learning reading writing and arithmetic in barrier free environment. The children with difficulties in activities of daily living are getting training on the same. The children are trained in combing, brushing, grooming and other personal skills.

HOME VISITS BY PROFESSIONALS:

Apart from the Centre based rehabilitation services to the children with intellectual & developmental disabilities, this institute has been also extending its services in home based environment. Under this, the professionals are visiting the houses of the needy persons with severe / multiple disabilities probably on Saturday and providing need based intervention in the home based environment by using local teaching & training materials. They are also providing training to the parents / siblings and motivating them to achieve good results.

PARENT TEACHER MEETING:

The Mercy Rehabilitation Center has been conducting parents meetings and discussing all the issues which are essential to the development of appropriate rehabilitation services at the center premises every month. Thus a total of 10 such meetings were conducted by the institute during the financial year 2014-15. In this program the parents of children with intellectual & developmental disabilities have been actively participating and sharing their views & opinions which strengthens the performance of the center.

INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION:

The organization has arranged a special function on the eve of Independence Day celebrations on 15.08.2015 at the special school premises. On this occasion Sri Arvind Singh, Secretary of Institute had hoisted the National Flag and appreciated the faculty members, parents and children for good cause of action for the rehabilitation of children with intellectual disabilities.



TEACHERS DAY CELEBRATION:

This Institute had arranged a special function on the eve of Teacher's day celebrations 2014 at the special school premises in which the children with intellectual disabilities have participated in cultural events. The need and the role of teachers in the rehabilitation process of children with intellectual disabilities were elaborated on this occasion.

CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITY:

The children of Muskan Special School and Rehab Center have participated International Day for Persons with Disability, 3rd December, 2014. The children with disability were participated from Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, Department of Social Welfare and Non Governmental Organization of the district. They have participated in various activities conducted during the celebration. Our children got prizes in quiz and competitions. Few glimpses are as follows:



PANDIT DEENDAYAL UPADHYAYA JAYANTI:

Mercy Rehabilitation Society has celebrated PANDIT DEENDAYAL UPADHYAYA Jayanti on 25 SEPTEMBER, 2015 in the school premises. The children were very enthusiastic on this occasion. The President, Secretary and other member of 1916 – 11 February 1968) was an Indian philosopher, economist, sociologist, historian, journalist, and political scientist. He was one of the most important leaders of the Bharatiya Jana Sangh, the forerunner of the present day Bharatiya Janata Party. A revered icon [citation needed] of integral humanism, he was an ideologue and a guiding force for an alternative model of governance and politics.



HOME BASED EDUCATION:

Mercy Rehabilitation Center has commitment to work with community therefore the Home Based Education program has been conducting in Chauth ka Barwara Block. The rehabilitation profession is visiting the 8 villages of Chauth ka Barwara Block. The children with disability are getting services with qualified rehabilitation professional at their home. A total of 18 children with disability are getting benefit from this project. 15 children are enrolled in regular school and 3 are not enrolled. The children with severe and profound disability are receiving training in activities of daily living. The children have better improvement in their conditions. The parents of children are happy with the services.

NIRAMAYA HEALTH INSURANCE:

In order to enable and empower persons with developmental disability to live as independently and as fully as possible, health services and their access to persons with

developmental disabilities assume a very significant role. In this context, Mercy Rehabilitation Center has enrolled 29 children with developmental disabilities under Niramaya Health Insurance as health insurance facility becomes important but presently such products are not easily available in general insurance for persons with developmental disabilities.

VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION CENTER:

Vocational rehabilitation is very much essential for the economic independence of any person. To provide quality individualized services and enhance skills in person with disabilities and to obtain employment. Persons with Disability will work closely with a Vocational Instructor throughout the process. Through active participation in their rehabilitation, people with disabilities achieve a greater level of independence in their work place therefore Mercy Rehabilitation Society, Sawaimadhopur has started a Vocational Training Center for the Person with Disability since April 2014.

In spite of these, the organization continuously working with them and a total of 200 persons with disability got benefitted with disability certificate, railway pass etc. Mercy Rehabilitation Society, Sawaimadhopur has been doing awareness generation programme in the community, survey, parents counseling, supporting in aids and appliances distribution etc.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT / VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM:

Mercy Rehabilitation Society, had been implemented a project namely Skill development / Vocational Training program in collaboration with Vishwa Yuvak Kendra, New Delhi from 1st April, 2014 to 31st of March, 2015. The program is implemented at Sawaimadhopur & Chothka Barbara blocks of Sawaimadhopur, Rajasthan for the year 2014-15. Vishwa Yuvak Kendra had taken good steps in this regard which is really appreciated. The first of all, survey was conducted in both the blocks and a total of 134 young and energetic youth were identified. After survey, six days entrepreneurship development training was organized for 50 selected youth.

The officers from Mercy Rehabilitation Society, Sawaimadhopur were made good linkage to the ITI, Jan Shikshan Sansthan, Local Industries, NGOs and private institute

for the training of those youth who were got training in six days Entrepreneurship Development Training. They were trained in diverse category of trades as per the interest. Finally, the youth who got training in different branch got placement at Private/Governmental/Non-Governmental Organization. Some of them established their own entrepreneurship. All are living life with economic independence.

SUCCESS STORY:

Master Yuvraj Singh, a special child student of Mercy Special School and Rehab Centre, Sawaimadhopur. The special teachers assessed him and they have found the current level Master Yuvraj. He was not able to identifying Numbers 1 to 10 and not able to tell 1 to 10 orally; he was not able to Identifying, naming, matching colors like red, green, blue, yellow, white, orange and black; not able to climbing stairs up and getting down; not able to walk independently on plain and uneven surface; not able to Identify and match shapes circle, square and triangle and he was not able to name fruits such as apple, banana, grapes, mango and pine apple and vegetables such as tomato, potato etc. The special teacher made good effort and trained Master Yuvraj and now he is able to identifying numbers 1 to 5, able to tell 1to 10 orally; identifying, naming, matching colors red, green, blue, yellow, white, orange and black; walking independently on plain and uneven surface; identifying and matching shapes circle, square and triangle; naming fruits such as apple, banana, grapes, mango and pine apple and vegetables such as tomato, potato etc. and his social skills and communication skills improved.
