Management committee of Mercy Rehabilitation Society, Sawai Madhopur is very much dedicated towards organization. We have followed legal procedure and Constitution of organization in constituting committee. The committee has power and responsibilities to manage the affairs of organization.

JOURNEY OF ORGANIZATION FROM DIRECTOR'S PEN : I came to know that my son (Yuvraj Singh) is mentally challenge about 5 years after my son was born on October 3, 2000. I made a lot of efforts to improve my son and went to many institutes from big doctors. Took advice but no solution. Finally exhausted, I went to NIMH Secunderabad where my son's proper investigation and counseling was done and after that I came to know that there could be some improvement in the son but could not be fully fit since then I worry about my son. I pledged to work for such differently abled children by forming an organization.

On 19 August 2008, the Mercy Rehabilitation Society, an organization for the welfare of differently-abled children, was formed and all the members of the society came together with a moto for the development and cooperation of such children in a dedicated spirit.

In 2008, the Institute started a Rehab Center-cum-Special School in Gangapur City, Sawai Madhopur, after which gradually other children of the district including the surrounding started getting involved with the institution and gradually the number of children in the institution increased significantly.

We were trying to rehabilitate about 25 children and the organization was financially weak as soon as we continued the work of advancing the organization, in the meantime, on 30 October 2013, my son left home and He missed out. Despite working hard day and night, the son was not found anywhere. After a lot of effort, we got frustrated and finally we started searching online. We also took the help of the child helpline at the same time, but the son did not know about it. Finally, after 14 days, information was received from the Alwar CHILDLINE that a boy has been found there, which is similar to

your stated opening, as soon as we get the information. Arrived in Alwar and identified the son and completed the paperwork and brought him back to the sitting, then through the District Collector, we opened the open shelter home and childline in Sawai Madhopur district. There was no Children Home Shelter Home or Child Line Service in Sawai Madhopur before it was requested to operate.

On my request, the District Collector forwarded the file and uploaded it and in 2014 We got J J Act registration. In February 2014, we started Shelter Home, in which so far more than 700 children have been transported to their families. On 18 May 2018, the institution got the approval to start a CHILDLINE center in Sawai Madhopur, since then we have been working continuously for child protection and rights area.

For the first four to five years, there was no grant from anywhere. Our family members along with the local people told hands and continued to run the organization but in 2014 we got approval from the Central Government to run a special school cum rehab center. Now it seems that the main purpose of our life has become to promote the children of society along with the son.

In the field of supporting children, our family as well as the staff of our organization are getting a lot of support. Staff are also working day and night in the service of children with a dedicated spirit.

OBJECTIVES OF THE ORGANIZATION:

- To provide educational and therapeutic services to children disability.
- To run Special Schools cum Rehabilitation Center.
- To share intellectual, social & cultural among children with disabilities.
- To raise public awareness about rights, vulnerability and protection of child.
- To work for homeless, missing and orphan children.
- To conduct special camps in rural & urban areas for identification.
- To provide vocational training and start income generating programs.
- To implement Community Based Rehabilitation Programs for disabled.
- To reach out to every child in need and ensure their rights and protection.
- To catalyze systems / civil society through active advocacy.
- To make child protection everybody's priority.

1. RESIDENTIAL SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR CHILDREN WITH MULTIPLE DISABILITIES:

Director, Special Aabled, Social Justice and Empowerment Department, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur has sanctioned Residential Special School For Children With Multiple Disabilities to Mercy Rehabilitation Society, Sawai Madhopur since 3rd December, 2016. 50 children are enrolled in Special School. School has facilities for educational, therapeutic and training services such as daily living skills, developing all-round development of the child, developing ability to move around in the environment, simple day-to-day activities, rehabilitation program and co-curricular activity etc. in barrier free environment.

Covid-19 pandemic affected all over world. Children with disabilities are also affected with this. School was closed in almost full session. The children with disability has additional problem with respect to the normal children. School has taken initiative to provide educational services in the ration of children with and special teacher is one-one. The special teacher visited home and provided support to children with disability. The parents were counselled to take care of these children with disability.

Online teaching program also implemented for the children with disability due to covid-19 pandemic. The material was shared with concern child. Parents were provided proper guidance to provide educational as well as therapeutic support to children with disability.

Special school is specially more helping children with severe and profound disability as are more in need. The staffs are very much bounded with the children therefore they are provided services in dedication manner. Children showing good performance.

2. OPEN SHELTERS HOME FOR CHILDREN IN NEED

Ministry of Women & Child Development, Government of India has been provided open shelter for children in need in urban area under the Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS), a centrally sponsored scheme of government–civil society partnership to Mercy rehabilitation society since 2015-16. The specific objectives of Open Shelter Home are as follows:

- To provide essential services to missing, homeless and orphan children.
- To enhance capacities of persons who involved in service delivery
- To create database and knowledge base for child protection services.
- To strengthen child protection at family and community level
- To coordinate and network with government institutions and non-government institutions to ensure effective implementation of shelter home.
- To raise public awareness about child rights, child vulnerability and child protection services.

The largest numbers of homeless children, street and working children, child substance abusers and child beggars, left on their own and in need of care and support, reside in urban areas. The main purpose of shelter home is to provide food, stay and other requirement on temporary basis for the homeless, orphan or who away from home.

Employment oriented / Vocational / Skill development training has been provided to children who are residing in Open Shelter Home. Children got training in in preparation of newspapers/paper envelopes, button hanging, painting, paper cutting, grating, photo frame etc. Two children are residing since last session 2019-20 whereas newly admitted

/ residential children in the session 2020-21 are zero. Two children rehabilitated in the financial year 2020-21 whereas continuous residing children in the Open shelter Home is nil.

Vikash Upadhyay, a resident of the home, participated in the district level poster painting competition organized by the Legal Services Authority, in which the said child was rewarded by the Legal Services Authority for coming first in the district.

Indoor activities and entertainment activities were done to the children residing/admitted in the home during covid-19 pandemic such as Yoga, Carrom, Ludo, Chess, Badminton, Poetry, storytelling, TV etc.

During covid-19, an awareness campaign was conducted at the door of the shelter home about the precautions to be taken to protect children and people from corona virus. During this, mask-sanitizers were distributed to the children and people by emphasizing on the proper use of masks and sanitizers. During the session 2020-21 by the shelter home, 13 children struggling legally were made a special quarantine home on the orders of the Superintendent Observation Home during covid-19 in which 18 children were admitted to the shelter home.

MR certificate of Suraj, a child residing in the shelter home, was made and the child was transferred to MR home. And one child was sent to home district Pune CWC. 18 children were connected with day-care facility by surveying the children of slum

habitation by the shelter home. As per the instructions of the Legal Services Authority, the children and staff of the Mercy Shelter Home took an oath to abide by the Constitution of India on the occasion of Constitution Foundation Day on 26 November. Children got benefited with shelter home and they returned to their home. Counselling sessions were conducted for their parents.

3. CHILDLINE SERVICES 1098

Mercy Rehabilitation Society has been running CHILDLINE Services in Sawai Madhopur since 2018. CHILDLINE has been ensuring to reach out to every child in need and ensure their rights and protection, connect through technology to reach the 'last mile', catalyze systems through active advocacy, collaborate through integrated efforts and child protection everybody's priority and project is supported by the Ministry of Women and Child Development, New Delhi.

Whole world is facing challenges of covid-19 and we also in same path therefore CHILDLINE came as front line worker and supporting the people in need. During the lock down, about 5000 masks were distributed to the migrant people, children, local, urban / rural residents from outside. CHILDLINE did survey and identified 18 children and they were mainstreamed during session 2020-21 for their education.

Looking the factor of employment, CHILDLINE taken step to do awareness/survey program of children involved in child labor under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act/MNREGA. During the lock down, food was distributed to the migrant / labourer and children who came from outsides are as follows:

The banner “We Are Not lock Down”, to aware/send message/share message people that CHILDLINE is working during lockdown, was placed at 59 places during April to June, 2020. The places are as follows: Railway Station General Hospital, Collectorate, Police Stations/Posts, Bus stop, Circle/intersection, Municipal Council and Gas Agency.

Awareness programs such as Rally Program, Rangoli Program, Good Touch Bad Touch, Like Sister, Komal Movie and Speech Program were conducted by CHILDLINE. CHILDLINE Child Line Team Member, Kapil Swarnakar, Lovely Jain were awarded by the Chairperson of the Child Protection Commission, Mrs. Sangeeta Beniwal and members Dr. Vijender Singh and Dr. Shailendra Pandya for admirable work done by CHILDLINE, Sawai Madhopur in the field of child protection.
